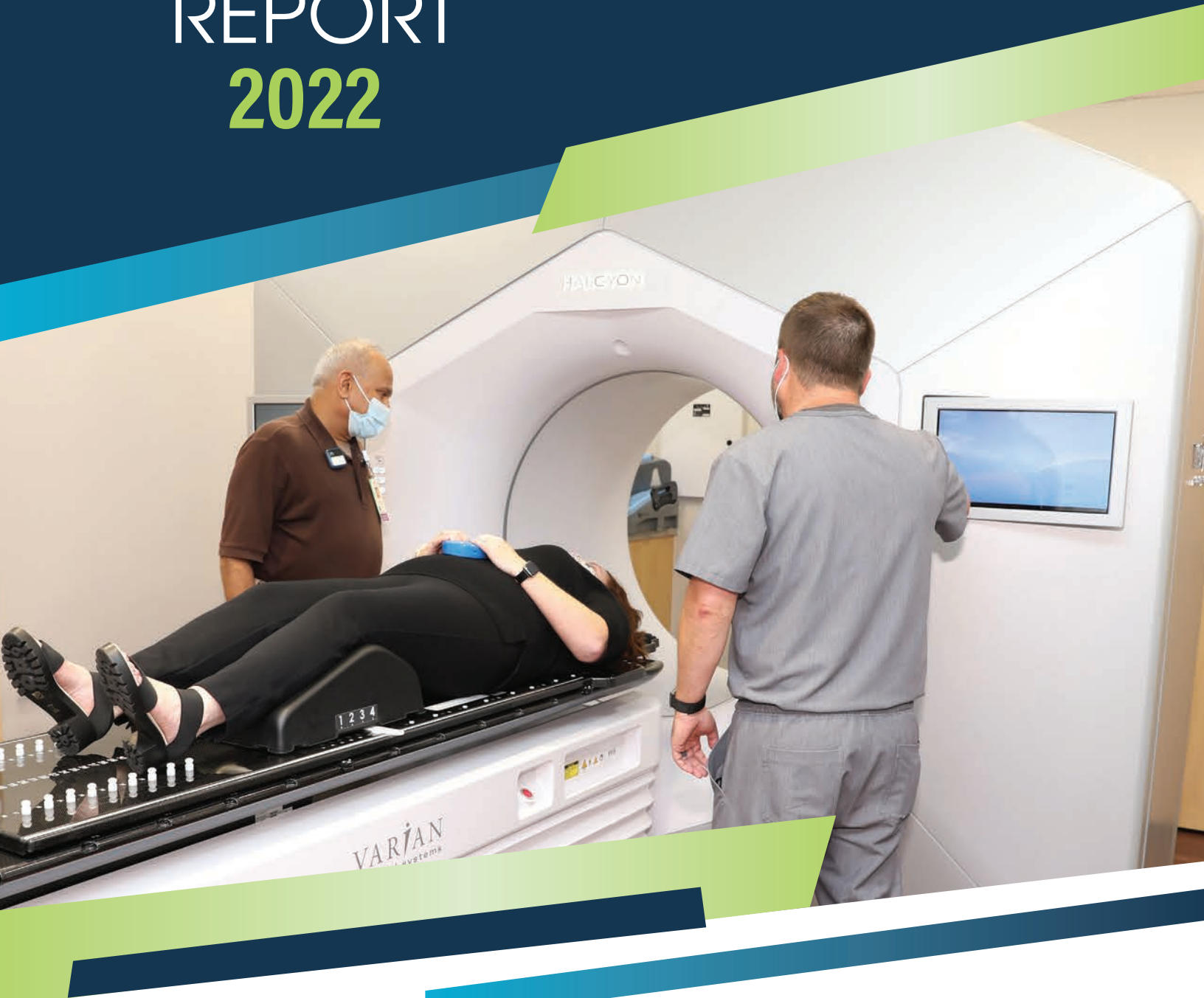

SURGERY

Q: Teree, tell us what led you to Jennie Stuart Health and share a little about your role with the Surgery Department?

"I was a very young mom who needed a job. The Materials Manager at the time (Jerry Russell) hired me to work in the print shop part-time. He was aware I needed full-time work, so after a few months of working in the print shop he came to me and said he found me a full-time position. I was so excited, that is until we stopped in front of the Surgery Department doors. I was terrified but I took the plunge. If he had faith in me, I had faith in me as well. Nancy Ellis was Director of the O.R. at the time and she hired me on the spot. I took home several books and studied. And the rest is history. I am still here today. I am the surgery scheduler so I don't do hands-on patient care, but I feel the job I do is important. I schedule patient surgeries and set the schedule for each day. With some patients, alternate procedures must be scheduled in conjunction with their O.R. procedure, and I set those up as well. I contact vendors with surgery dates and times that they will be needed. I stay in contact with all the surgeons and their offices to make sure everything runs smoothly."

Q: Forty-five years is a significant milestone! What has most influenced your decision to stay with Jennie Stuart Health for so many years?

"I love what I do. I learn something new every single day. With new surgeons and new technology there are always new procedures and new techniques. I love being a part of it even in a small way. The way every member of our team comes together for each and every patient to ensure they are well taken care of. I am also a very hands-on mom and grandmother. If one of my children had an event that I needed to attend I didn't have to worry about whether I would have to work or not. I have always had a Monday - Friday, no weekend, no holiday schedule. It works so well for a single parent. I don't have to look back and have regrets that I missed a single thing, because I didn't."

Q: What do you find most rewarding about your work and being a part of #TeamJennie?

"The people! We are family! We may not always get along, but we are always there for each other. We are a team! I have worked with so many amazing surgeons and staff over the years. Some sadly are no longer with us, but I have such fond memories of each and every one."

"What a privilege it is to support the JSH Foundation! COMMUNITY IMPACT

In 2022, your Annual Fund contributions of \$70,581 have provided much care, support and encouragement for Jennie Stuart patients, employees and providers. A copy of the Foundation's Form 990 may be found on our website.



In 2022 Tree of Life funds provided patients undergoing cancer treatment with the following:

- Medication assistance
- Compression sleeves for lymphedema
- Transportation assistance to treatment appointments
- Printed materials for patient support
- Financial assistance for patients experiencing additional barriers to treatment and healing



- To date in 2022, 137 members of #TeamJennie have been recognized as Care Champions for going above and beyond in providing exceptional care.
- Since the Care Champion program began in 2020, nearly 480 Jennie Stuart providers and employees have been honored by grateful patients for their outstanding service.



- In 2022, nineteen (19) Jennie Stuart employees received financial assistance to help overcome an unexpected hardship.
- The Kentucky Hospital Association provided \$25,891 from their HERO Fund for Jennie Stuart employees impacted by the tornadoes in late 2021.

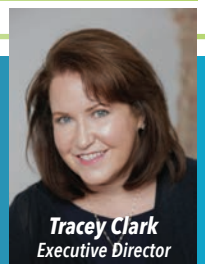
