SUPPORT SERVICES

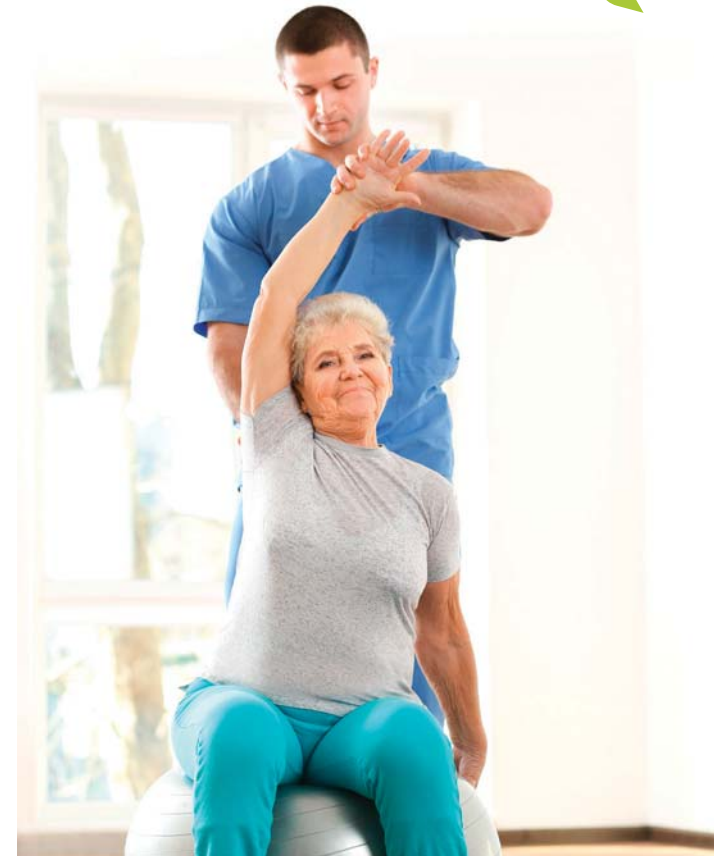
Medical social workers are available to assist you and your family in finding ways to cope when stressful issues affect your recovery.

REHABILITATION SERVICES AND TEAM

Physical therapy. To help maximize mobility, physical therapists evaluate and provide individualized programs for strengthening and coordination exercises, pain control and other therapeutic treatments.

Speech therapy. To help maximize communication and to treat swallowing disorders. Speech therapists evaluate and provide individualized treatment plans to address speech, language, swallowing, cognitive and voice disorders.

Occupational therapy. To help maximize independence in activities of daily living, occupational therapists evaluate and provide exercise and adaptive techniques for self-care.
