HAEMOPHILUS INFLUENZAE TYPE B (HIB) IS A BACTERIAL ILLNESS THAT CAN LEAD TO A POTENTIALLY DEADLY INFECTION IN YOUNG CHILDREN.

MOSTLY AFFECTING CHILDREN UNDER 5 YEARS OLD.

MENINGITIS IS THE MOST COMMON HIB RELATED ILLNESS.

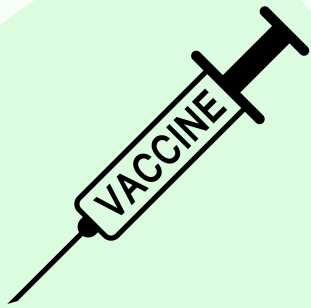
